## Highlands

**Glenmorangie Original** 13

*Nose offers fruit, butterscotch and toffee with vanilla, fruit soft tannins and peat combining for a warm finish*

**Oban 14yo** 16

*Nose is rich and smoky, with seaweed, tar and citrus notes that finishes with dry oak*

**Oban Distillers Edition** 20

*Similar to the 14yo but has a rich smoke on the palate with a lingering spice finish. Superb.*

**Blair Athol** 20

*The nose is initially slightly prickly, with sweet notes emerging: Apple and subtle smoke present on the palate with dried fruits, spice and aniseed.*

## Lowlands

**Auchentoshan** 13

*Light, sweet and smooth in the mouth, with citrus fruit, cloves and a gingery finish*

**Auchentoshan (Three Wood)** 16

*Fruit and syrup. Hazelnut with hints of cinnamon and lemon. A butterscotch sweetness adds to the overall complexity.*

**Glenkinchie** 16

*Light flowery nose with a hint of grass and cucumber. Palate is barley with a touch of spice and an earthy note.*

## Speyside

### anCnoc 16yo

25

*Robust on the nose featuring honeysuckle, cereals and barley, and has a nicely sweet mocha, winter spice Madeira flavour. Medium length finish with oak and barley interaction.*

### Glenlivet

13

*Lovely honeyed, floral and fragrant nose with a smooth malt and vanilla sweetness on the palate*

### Glenlivet XXV

55

*A superb expression of this distinguished distillery, finished in sherry casks for its final 2 years. A seamless combination of honey, dried fruit and spice that emerges on the palate and peaks on the finish*

### Glenfiddich 12yo

14

*Classic rich fruit and barley nose with a sharp malt palate and warming finish*

### Glenfarclas 15yo

25

*A Classic Highland malt with hints of raisins, orange peel, sherry and walnuts. A liquid Christmas cake. Astonishing! Drinks like a 20yo.*

### The Macallan 12yo

16

*Abundant fruit combined with sweet syrup. The solid oak rounds out a good lengthy finish*

### Longmorn 16yo

18

*Apple, toffee cream and spice on the nose, the Longmorn has a medium body with lovely fudge, butter and more spicy notes on the palate, and a long oaky finish.*

### Dailuaine 16yo

28

*With a rich and full nose, this 16 year old flourishes on the palate, with notes of sherry, nuts, ripe oranges and fruitcake, red berries and a little smoke. Not available in Australia and must be purchased directly from the distillery, or from here.*

### Benrinnes 15yo

20

*A complex and savoury whisky, showing peppery, leathery and caramel flavours and a medium to long finish. Also not available in Australia, and must be purchased directly from the distillery, or from here.*

## The Islands

### Isle of Jura

15

*A resin, oil and pine note to the nose that combines to deliver a light malty, nutty and salt finish with a hint of smoke.*

### Tobermory (Mull) 15yo

22

*Finished in Sherry Oloroso casks this dram exudes Christmas cake, spice and smoke flavours with a long and luxurious chocolate coated raisin finish.*

### Talisker (Skye) 10yo

13

*A complex dense smoky nose with sweet fruit and fish that delivers dark chocolate, ginger and black pepper in a spicy smoky tail.*

### Talisker Distiller's Edition

20

*Lightly peated, with a smokey finish which lingers long and reveals spice notes, black pepper and clove*

### Highland Park 12yo (Orkney)

16

*Fragrant and floral with hints of white heather and spice. Smooth and honeyed with fruit on the palate and potpourri finish.*

### Highland Park 18yo (Orkney)

28

*A richer finish than its younger sibling with the creaminess of cinnamon and allspice and a long herbal sugared finish.*

## Islay Malts

**Bowmore (Islay)** 15

*Rich peat and seaweed nose with zesty lemon, menthol and smoke in a complex finish*

**Bowmore (Islay) 17yo** 28

*A luscious creamy toffee and malty sweetness combines with a warm smokiness. Incredibly smooth, warm and comforting*

**Caol Ila (Islay)** 15

*Iodine, smoked bacon and fish feature on the nose along with some fruit that remerge on a peppery peaty finish*

**Bunnahabhain (Islay) 12yo** 15

*Restrained for an Islay, the Bunnahabhain has a fresh nose with not too much peat. The smoke is more overt on the palate, along with nuts and fruits. The finish is long and full bodied, with hints of vanilla.*

**Kilchoman (Islay) 10yo** 22

*Lovely balance between fruits (especially lemon) and a light peat smoke. A long and lively finish. For a newcomer to Islay it has certainly found its feet.*

**Bruichladdich (Islay)** 15

*A light elegant nose of fruit and vanilla that is smooth and stylish with nuts and spicy oak in the finish*

**Laphroaig 10yo (Islay)** 14

*Salt, peat, seaweed and tar in a glorious nose that's followed by a massive palate with fish oil & plankton, culminating in a long phenolic and peaty finish.*

**Laphroaig Quarter Cask (Islay)** 16

*Deep, complex and smoky yet offers and surprises the palate with a gentle sweetness*

## Islay Malts

### Laphroaig 15yo (Islay) 25

*A touch of water releases salted caramel notes and its signature Islay peaty smoke underlying sweet orchard fruit and wet tobacco*

### Laphroaig 18yo (Islay) 30

*An intense depth that is exceptionally balanced and warming. Complete with all the characteristics that makes Laphroaig one of the kings of peat. Delicious!*

### Laguvalin 16yo (Islay) 18

*A monster truck nose full of smoke, lychee and pear with banana and smoke notes on the palate this finishes with dark chocolate and a rich smoke*

### Ardbeg 10yo (Islay) 14

*Traditionally the smokiest of whiskeys with over 50 phenol parts per million. With its deep, smoky notes with luscious, raisiny tones of old ex-Sherry casks, it's non-chill-filtered at high strength whilst retaining maximum flavor*

### Ardbeg Uigeadail (Islay) 21

*Rich and weighty with heady and smoky aromatics. A burst of winter spices sets off a smoky-spicy explosion countered by a sumptuous mid-palate of honey glazed smoked food finishing with an amazingly long and chewy treacle, deep mocha and smoke.*

### Ardbeg Corryvreckan 23

*Taking its name from the famous whirlpool that lies to the north of Islay, where only the bravest souls dare to venture. Swirling aromas and torrents of deep, peaty, peppery taste lurk beneath the surface of this beautifully balanced dram.*


