




The Curtiss P-40 Warhawk is unmistakenly one of the most iconic symbols of WWII and American aviation.


Pictured: Abraham Wald, between 1945-50

Innovative and out-of-the-box thinking drove America's success in WWII, changing the way we think about strategies and exploring even the most peculiar of ideas.


